What we do

In European Solidarity Corps, we act as a sending and receiving organization. It means that Czech people willing to volunteer abroad can count on our support, and foreign people can come to our office in Brno as ESC volunteers.

Library of Things is our local project. There are things that people only need to use once, and it's not ecological or economical to buy them - that's why we rent them! As our volunteer, you will help us manage the rentals, keep the catalog and storage in order, and create content for the Library's social media.

Erasmus+

We organize youth exchanges and training courses in the Czech Republic. A group of Czech and foreign young people goes with us on a week-long trip outside of Brno. We work together on a themed project, for example, developing leadership skills or raising environmental awareness. As our volunteer, you help us with the activities and can enjoy the trip and learn new skills.

What we do



Promoting youth mobility We run accounts on Instagram and Facebook, and the website where we promote Erasmus+ and ESC as exciting and enriching opportunities for young people. We encourage our Brno volunteers to share their experience. We also stay in touch with the volunteers we send abroad and give them the opportunity to tell their stories on our social media.



We use our space to organize events for the local community. Our regular clothes swaps bring over 100 people to give away the clothes they no longer wear and get new pieces for their closet. With our language clubs, everyone can practise the language they're learning or teach their language to others. We're also open to your initiatives and can help you to put your event ideas into practice!

Our city - Brno



Brno is the second biggest city in the Czech Republic. Thanks to lots of restaurant, bars, shops, cinemas and theatres, you will never get bored here! The city is surrounded by beautiful green areas, easily accessible for allday trips. If you like visiting big cities, it's a perfect base for that too! With many bus and train connections, weekend trips to Prague, Vienna, Bratislava and Budapest await you!



Practical information



Accommodation

You don't have to worry about accommodation, we do it for you! You will stay in a single room, either in the dormitory close to the city centre or in a flat shared with other volunteers, located in a beautiful green part of Brno. Accommodation is covered by the EU funds.



Money

Another thing you don't have to worry about! European Solidarity Corps is a project funded by the European Union. As our volunteer in Brno, you don't have to pay anything! Every month, you get pocket money in the amount sufficient to pay all the necessary living expenses and enjoy your life in Brno, as well as to go on trips in the Czech Republic and the nearby countries. EU grant also covers the accommodation, your ticket to the Czech Republic and back, and public transport card in Brno.

Practical information



Health insurance

Having an EHIC card, you're allowed to use the health services in the Czech Republic on the same rules as Czech citizens. Additionally, you are insured in the Cigna insurance company, which pays for the health-related expensed not covered by EHIC. If you aren't eligible for EHIC, you can use the Cigna insurance for all the health services covered by the plan.

Youthpass

Youthpass is a nonformal education certificate - a proof of the work you did during your volunteering experience and the skills you gained. It's also a form of self-evaluation because you fill it in yourself at the end of the project. We offer you all the necessary help! You can show it to your future potential employers to increase your chance of getting hired.

Additional support

We take good care of our volunteers! We'll give you tips for getting around the city and spending time inside and outside of Brno. We'll find a local mentor for you. We'll answer your questions related to volunteering and life in the Czech Republic.

Moreover, if you need a psychotherapist, psychiatrist or another specialist, we'll do our best to help you get the support. Don't let your individual needs discourage you from becoming our volunteer!
