



# ABOUT CONTEXT

One of the goal of this project is to encourage the growth of an enterprising culture among the young people to promote self-employment.

Through entrepreneurship project young people learn organizational skills, including time management, working with a team, leadership development and interpersonal skills, all of which are highly transferable skills sought by employers.

# About Venue

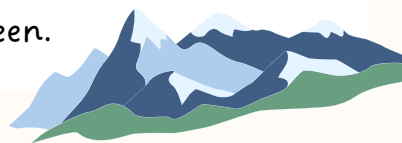
The majority of the project will take place in Manglisi Environmental Education Center (MEEC), however the participants will stay in Rustavi on the first and last day of the project, with transportation from Rustavi to Manglisi and back being covered by the host organization.



Manglisi is located on the Tbilisi-Tsalka highway, 56 kilometres west of Tbilisi, the capital of Georgia, in the Algeti river valley. It is located at about 1,200 metres (3,900 ft) above sea level and it functions as a mountain spa and health resort.

International Scout Centre Rustavi (<http://iscr.ge/>) - a local youth hostel which is located Old Rustavi address: Rustavi, Balanchivadze Str. 9

In both location, participants will be mainly accommodated by 3-4 persons in rooms. Boys will live separately from girls and the groups will be internationally mixed. There are shared bathrooms. Internet will be available for free during the whole stay, however, the speed of the internet can be slow, so it is better to do all jobs which require a fast internet connection prior to the exchange. All breakfasts, lunches, and dinners will be served at the canteen.
